LCC/2014/0101 – Hydrocarbons exploration site on agricultural land that forms part of Roseacre Hall to the west, north and east of Roseacre wood and land that forms part of the defence high frequency communications site between Roseacre Road and Inskip Road, Roseacre and Wharles, Lancashire

Medlar-with-Wesham Town Council have discussed the revised transport route strategy proposed by Cuadrilla and wish to make the following comments:-

- The Council's generic objection in principal to the site remains a concern
- The continual breaching conditions at other local Cuadrilla sites is of great concern and needs to be consider when reviewing any application.
- None of the routes proposed are safe or suitable for access.
- Strongly object to traffic from the site using the A583/A585 due:-
 - Traffic from the Preston New Road Site already uses this route. Three-way Cuadrilla traffic would be unsafe for parts of the route.
 - The heavy traffic flow already using the roads due to Mill Farm Development, housing and industrial units developments
 - The amount of roundabouts on the route creating hazards
 - Cross contamination may occur as the result of an accident
