HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

AND

ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

NOTICE is hereby given that Public Local Inquiries in connection with the Orders mentioned below will be held by an Inspector appointed for the purpose by the Secretary of State for Transport **beginning at 10.00am on Tuesday 1 August 2017 at the Banqueting Suite, The Cunard Building, Water Street, Liverpool, L3 1DF** to hear representations from remaining objectors (as defined in the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007) and statutory objectors (as defined in the Highways (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1994), from any other persons having an interest in the land the subject of the Compulsory Purchase Order and, at his discretion, to hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

NOTICE is hereby given that a Pre-Inquiries Meeting will be held at **the Banqueting Suite, The Cunard Building, Water Street, Liverpool, L3 1DF on Wednesday 24th May 2017 beginning at 10:00am** where the Inspector will arrange the timetable for the proceedings in connection with the Orders named below. The right to make representations at the Public Local Inquiries will in no way be prejudiced by the inability to attend or be represented at the Pre-Inquiries Meeting.

THE ORDERS are Orders which have been made by Liverpool City Council and Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council under the above-mentioned Acts and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation and are:-

(1) **THE LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL (A565 CLASSIFIED ROAD HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS) (NO 2) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2016.** This is an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, which, if confirmed, will authorise Liverpool City Council to:-

- (a) improve highways;
- (b) stop up highways;
- (c) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- (d) provide new means of access to premises,

at Ensor Street, Stone Street, Sherwood Street and Walter Street all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road known as A565 Great Howard Street/Derby Road which the Council are proposing to improve between its junction with Chadwick Street in the south and its junction with Millers Bridge in the north.

(2) **THE LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL (A565 HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS PHASE I) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2016.** This is an Order under sections 239, 240, 246, 250 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980, which, if confirmed, will authorise Liverpool City Council to purchase compulsorily the land and the new rights over land described therein for the purposes of:-

- (a) the construction for the improvement of the existing highway known as the A565

Great Howard Street.

- (b) the improvement or development of frontages to the Highway or of land adjacent to the Highway;
- (c) the carrying out of drainage works in connection with the construction or improvement of the Highway;
- (d) the use of the land by the Acquiring Authority in connection with the construction and improvement of the Highway or other highways within its vicinity; and
- (e) mitigating any adverse effects which may arise associated with the construction or improvement of the Highway by the Acquiring Authority.

(3) THE LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL (A565 HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS PHASE II) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2016. This is an Order under sections 239, 240, 246, 250 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980, which, if confirmed, will authorise Liverpool City Council to purchase compulsorily the land and the new rights over land described therein for the purposes of:-

- (a) the construction for the improvement of the existing highway known as the A565 Derby Road;
- (b) the improvement or development of frontages to the Highway or of land adjacent to the Highway;
- (c) the carrying out of drainage works in connection with the construction or improvement of the Highway;
- (d) the use of the land by the Acquiring Authority in connection with the construction and improvement of the Highway or other highways within its vicinity; and
- (e) mitigating any adverse effects which may arise associated with the construction or improvement of the Highway by the Acquiring Authority.

(4) THE LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL (A565 HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS PHASE I) (No 2) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2016. This is an Order under sections 239, 240, 246, and 260 of the Highways Act 1980, which, if confirmed, will authorise Liverpool City Council to purchase compulsorily the land described therein for the purposes of:-

- (a) the improvement of existing highway at Stone Street and Sherwood Street, Liverpool;
- (b) the improvement or development of frontages to the Highway or of land adjacent to the Highway;
- (c) the carrying out of drainage works in connection with the construction or improvement of the Highway;
- (d) mitigating any adverse effects which may arise associated with the construction or improvement of the Highway by the Acquiring Authority.

(5) THE SEFTON METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (A565 HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2016. This is an Order under sections 239, 240, 246, 250 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980, which, if confirmed, will authorise Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council to purchase compulsorily the land and the new rights over land described therein for the purposes of:-

- (a) the construction for the improvement of the existing highway known as the A565

Derby Road;

- (b) the improvement or development of frontages to the Highway or of land adjacent to the Highway;
- (c) the carrying out of drainage works in connection with the construction or improvement of the Highway;
- (d) the use of the land by the Acquiring Authority in connection with the construction and improvement of the Highway or other highways within its vicinity; and
- (e) mitigating any adverse effects which may arise associated with the construction or improvement of the Highway by the Acquiring Authority.

COPIES of the above-mentioned Orders (1 to 4) and of the plans referred to therein have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours free of charge at the offices of Liverpool City Council, Municipal Buildings, Dale Street, Liverpool L2 2DH and copies of the above-mentioned Order (5) and of the plans referred to therein have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours free of charge at the offices of Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council, Magdalen House, 30 Trinity Road, Bootle L20 3NJ.

COPIES of any proofs of evidence, sent to or by the promoting authority, are also available for inspection at both addresses given above from **4 July 2017**.

PROCEEDINGS on the above-mentioned Orders are being taken concurrently by virtue of Section 257 of the Highways Act 1980.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT hereby directs that any person who intends to submit at the Inquiries that any highway or proposed highway to which the Orders, or either of them, relate should follow an alternative route, or that, instead of improving, diverting or altering a highway to which the Orders, or either of them, relate, a new highway should be constructed on a particular route, shall send to him at Department for Transport, National Transport Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle upon Tyne NE4 7AR, not later than **4 July 2017**, sufficient information about the alternative route or the route of the new highway, as the case may be, to enable it to be identified. Failure to comply with this direction will entitle the Secretary of State and the person holding the Inquiries to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.
