Dear Mrs Haigh

I now attach a first Draft s.106 UU with the relevant plan Appendices.

I have copied your engineer, Mr. Akhtar, who is familiar with the site, for any comments on the proposed Verge Works as detailed in the Second Schedule.

As I have stated previously to yourself and others, the monetary amount is not yet included. We are first allowing the Council to comment on the proposed works. We would then invite the Council to offer what it believes is the appropriate cost. Where the Council would not wish to do this, then we shall go with quotes which we shall share with you in due course. Nevertheless, we thought that the Council would wish to comment on the works and prospective costs first.
