I wish to **object** to the diversion of the above footpath for the following reason.

The footpath forms part of the Holme Valley Circular walk and is a very popular section because it links directly with the permissive footpath to Wolfstones Heights Trig Point. This affords magnificent views of the valley below. Holmfirth 60 emerges onto Wolfstones Road directly opposite this path. The proposed diversion would mean that people going to the Trig Point would have to walk a couple of hundred yards along Wolfstones Road to pick up the permissive path. This route is surprisingly busy and is narrow, hilly and twisting with a 60 mph speed limit.

It is worthy of note that Kirklees Council Planning Application Decision Notice dated 16/6/2017 in response to Planning Application 2017/62/91374/W relating to Wolfstones Heights Farm, stated the following

NOTE: Public Footpath HOL/60/20 which crosses the application site shall not be unofficially obstructed or diverted at any time before, during or after development works.
