Dear Sirs,

In reference to the proposed diversion of the public right of way diversion at Wolfstones, Holmfirth.

My husband and I are residents of Netherthong and have been using both the original route and , (more recently,) the diversion on a regular basis, especially during lockdown. We walk as a couple and/or in groups of adults and also with our two young children.

We personally feel that the new route is a much safer alternative regardless of group size or age. The acute bend at the top of the original route is extremely hazardous, especially if children or dogs are running ahead. Visibility is poor in both directions, particularly when traffic is approaching from the north east (right out of the occupiers drive,) at speed. The verge of Wolfstones road from the revised exit point has been made safe and easy on the foot with substantial width, grass turf and boulders between pedestrian and vehicle terrain. Despite a marginally longer walkway on the road, we conclude public safety has been very courteously and genuinely considered.

I hope that you will relay our appreciation to the landowner and consider our approval in your consultation.
